- There will be free workshops on shooting and editing techniques in September with James Cox.
- Films must be submitted on **DVD format.**
- Deadline for submissions, **16 October 2009.**
- The winners will be announced on the last day of the Access All Areas festival, Sunday 25 October 2009. The winning films will be shown that evening on the big screen.
- The prizes on offer will be posted on the website.
