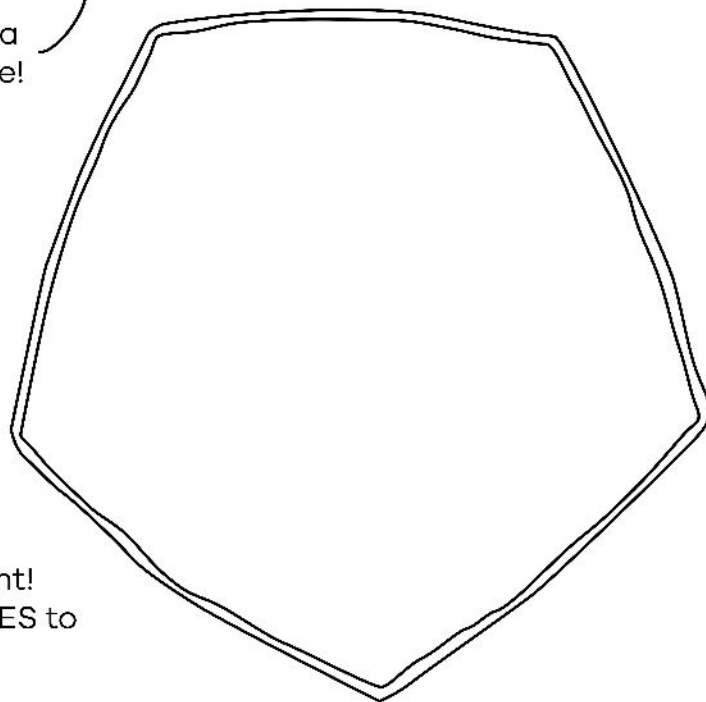
A person working or relaxing!



WATCH OUT! It's a choppy sea scene!




The horizon line where the sky meets the sea, the land or buildings!
